

Winter Exploration in Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks

Our group will fly from Atlanta to Jackson, WY where you will spend 5 Nights/6 Days at a beautiful Creekside Resort located on a Nature Preserve near the town of Jackson Hole. Watch the mule deer forage on the snow-covered ground right out your cabin window! Explore Yellowstone over snow packed roads in a comfortable & heated Snowcoach. Cross the Continental Divide, view wildlife such as bison and coyotes, and walk along active geothermal features in the Park, the most famous of which is Old Faithful. Take a horse-drawn sleigh ride into the National Elk Refuge and get within 20-30 feet of wild elk – there are thousands of them! Drive along Grand Teton National Park with views of the majestic snow-capped Teton Range on a Wildlife Safari Tour with a local Nature Guide and seek out Moose, Eagles and Dall sheep. Enjoy free time at Jackson town square, home to great restaurants, unique shops and those famous elk-antler arches. Explore on your own and relax or let us set up some optional excursions for you such as snowmobile tours, snowshoeing, dogsledding, a spa day, a visit to the National Museum of Wildlife Art, or you can choose to visit one of the oldest ranches on the rugged Wyoming landscape where you can enjoy an evening sleigh ride and a T-Bone steak dinner (additional fees apply for optional excursions.) We recommend only those who are comfortable walking in the snow/ice consider this trip. Basic winter attire is what you will need including a warm jacket, hat, warm gloves and waterproof boots and you will be all set to experience this unique and wonderful winter excursion! Tour departs from the Daniel's Tour Depot in Lula, GA and includes transportation to/from the Atlanta Airport, round-trip Air Atlanta/Jackson, 5 nights luxury accommodations in Jackson Hole, Yellowstone Snowcoach Tour, Grand Teton Wildlife Van Tour, National Elk Refuge Sleigh Ride - 6 Meals (5 Breakfasts, 1 Lunch) SMALL GROUP TOUR - LIMITED SPACE AVAILABLE!

Weather Preparedness and Packing List:

The winter temperature in the Yellowstone Region can vary from the single digits to the upper 30's during February. The average elevation is between 6,200 – 8,000 feet, so it is considered a high-elevation area. There is almost always plenty of snow on the ground. The snow plows stay very busy and keep the roads cleared enough for life to move along just fine during heavy snow fall in the region. In fact, winter is a high tourist season in the region because of the snow. You will need basic winter gear to enjoy the planned activities on this trip. We recommend layering clothes with a moisture wicking undershirt, lightweight shirts and heavier weight shirts, a warm vest, a warm and waterproof jacket (like a ski jacket). Bring waterproof gloves, a hat or hood, neck wrap or scarf, moisture wicking long johns or fleece leggings work well under pants. Warm socks and waterproof snow boots are a must, because you will most likely be walking in snow - a mid-calf snow boot is best.
